General Guidelines for Considering a Request

- Does the organization provide a needed service to the community/state?
- Does it serve a significant number of people in the community/state?
- Does it benefit the company or its employees?
- Does the work of the organization duplicate or significantly overlap the work of federal, state, or local public agencies?
- Does the organization serve the community/state without regard to race, color, religion, sex, age, familiar status, handicap, national origin, or public assistance?
- What percentage of the organization's revenues is used for administrative expenses?
- What percentage of the organization's proceeds is used to directly provide goods and services for citizens in the state of Florida?

Requests Typically Excluded from Consideration

- Personal assistance for individuals.
- Religious, labor, fraternal, or political causes.
- National organizations without local or regional chapters in the communities we serve.
- Courtesy advertising in program booklets, ad journals, yearbooks, etc.
- Freelance productions.
